W H E E L O F F O R T U N E : P R E P
Participants will be asked a series of PrEP-related CFAR research findings using a wheel of fortune game board! Great for a venue that offers a space where conversations are easily heard and room for the wheel!

S T I & R E S E A R C H M E M O R Y G A M E
Plushy STIs are matched with CFAR research findings about STIs. Great for a venue that may be loud (limited talking required).

**S A F E R U S E K I T
D E M O N S T R A T I O N**
Safer use kits are explored and kit supplied are demonstrated on how to use. CFAR research findings on substance use among BSGM are shared. Great for a venue that offers a space where conversations are easily heard.

T A B L I N G : C O M M U N I T Y
Tabling offers brief discussions about CFAR research related to community and social structures contributing to HIV and HIV-related outcomes. Great for any venue as post-cards are offered as well.

P A S S I V E D I S S E M I N A T I O N
Passive dissemination offers a way to share information about CFAR, without having CFAR staff at the event. This is best for events that are exclusive to community members.
